



The Bibolina collection opens up to the world of the office, with Bibolina Office bringing freshness and vitality to contemporary workspaces. Designed by Julie Richoz, Bibolina Office brings the founding qualities of the collection into the workplace: a readable structure, precise lines and the softness of solid oak. Tables become benches, and Bibolina's formal language adapts to new uses, from shared work to more intimate areas. Conceived as a modular and evolving system, Bibolina Office supports the transformation of workspaces. Elements combine and reconfigure easily. Assembly is deliberately simple, with a rational and readable construction. Through its proportions, materials and attention to detail, Bibolina Office offers a sober and warm approach to collective work furniture, combining functionality, durability and freshness.



Swiss-French designer Julie Richoz set up her eponymous design studio in Paris in 2015, through which she enjoys exploring with curiosity and sensibility the development of her own language through objects. From unique pieces to industrial scale, she sees a continuity rather than a difference between the two ways of production. In both cases, she is fascinated by the savoir-faire and the passion and precision in handling materials. Her practice ranges from objects, furniture, and lighting to textiles, for companies such as Alessi, Louis Poulsen, Hay, Mattiazzi, La Manufacture de Cogolin, Galerie kreo, among others. After graduating from ECAL University of Art and Design Lausanne (2012), she worked for Pierre Charpin as a project assistant (2013-2015). She was a designer-in-residence at CIRVA Research Center on Art and Glass, France (2013), at Sèvres - Cité de la Céramique, France (2013), and at Casa Wabi, Mexico (2017). She has been awarded the Grand Prix at Design Parade (2012), Swiss Design Awards (2015/2019), Bourse Leenaards (2016) and the Grand Prix de la Création de la ville de Paris (2023). Since 2017, Richoz has taught industrial design at ECAL University of Art and Design Lausanne, Switzerland. "

Bibolina Bench System

- 1 Modular bench system:** A structure designed for shared work, made up of combinable modules.
- 2 Mobile storage unit on castors:** A mobile storage solution that is both elegant and practical, easily movable according to use.
- 3 Mobile front divider:** A divider that can be freely positioned along the entire length of the central channel, adding privacy for face-to-face work.
- 4 Side divider:** A discreet element designed to separate two workstations and create an individual workspace.
- 5 Toolbox:** A solid oak storage accessory for everyday objects, inspired by the traditional toolbox.
- 6 Mobile tray:** A functional element that moves freely along the entire length of the central channel.
- 7 Lamp:** An individual light designed to integrate along the entire length of the bench, with 360° rotation capability.

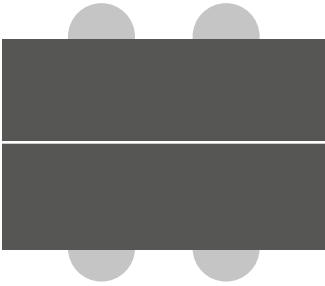

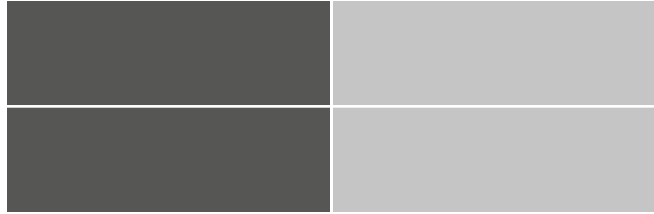

Bench table union

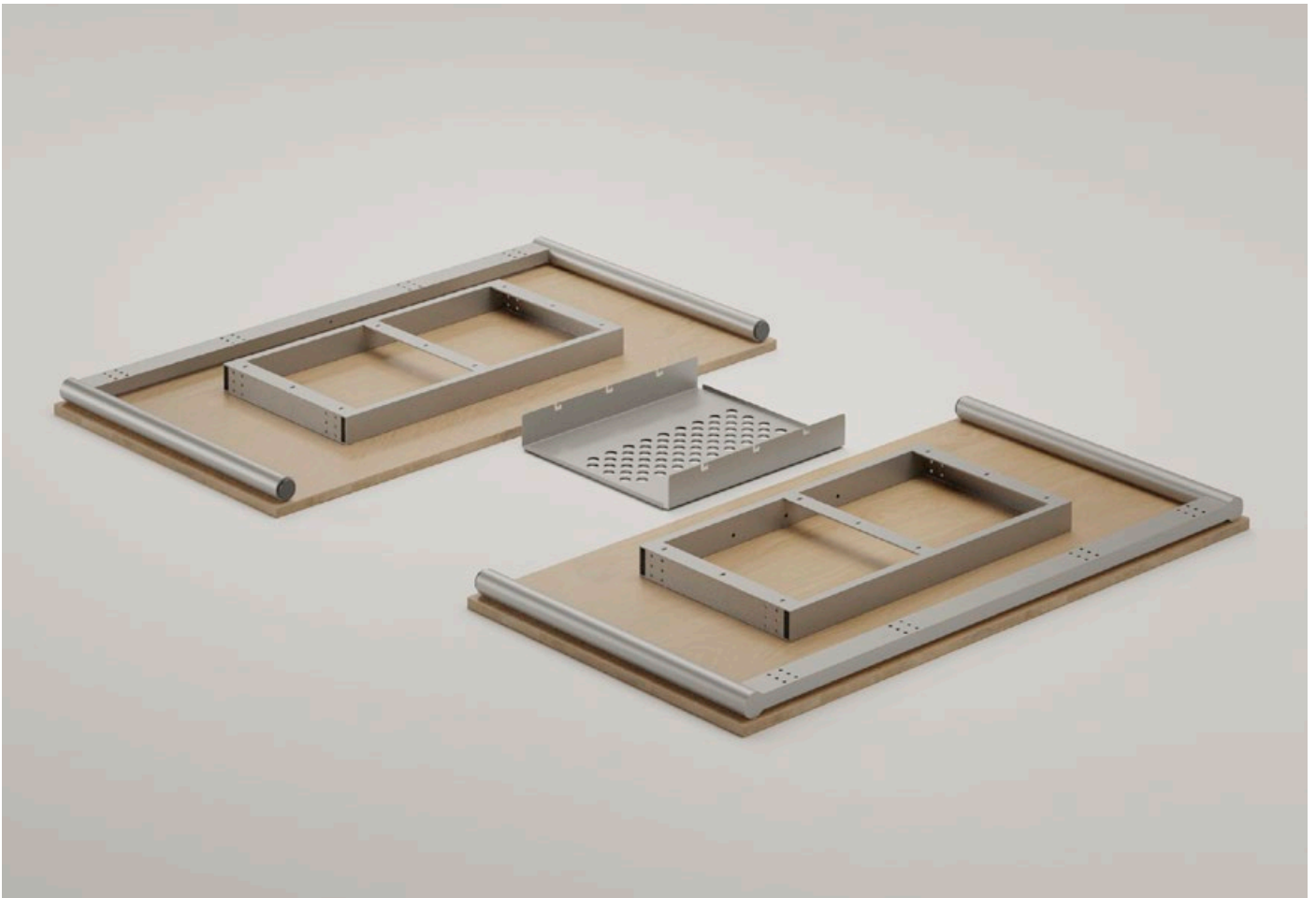

Bibolina Office creates a working atmosphere that is both calm and welcoming. The warmth of the wood, the simplicity of the lines and the modularity of the system encourage fluid use, conducive to both concentration and interaction.

The bench top is made of 22 mm thick three-ply solid oak. Along its length, the top features a slight radius that adds softness and ergonomics to the workstation.



Bibolina Office naturally combines with other Alki collections. This continuity makes it possible to create coherent and lively spaces.



The Bibolina divider structures workstations while preserving the overall fluidity. A functional element designed to adapt to different uses and configurations.

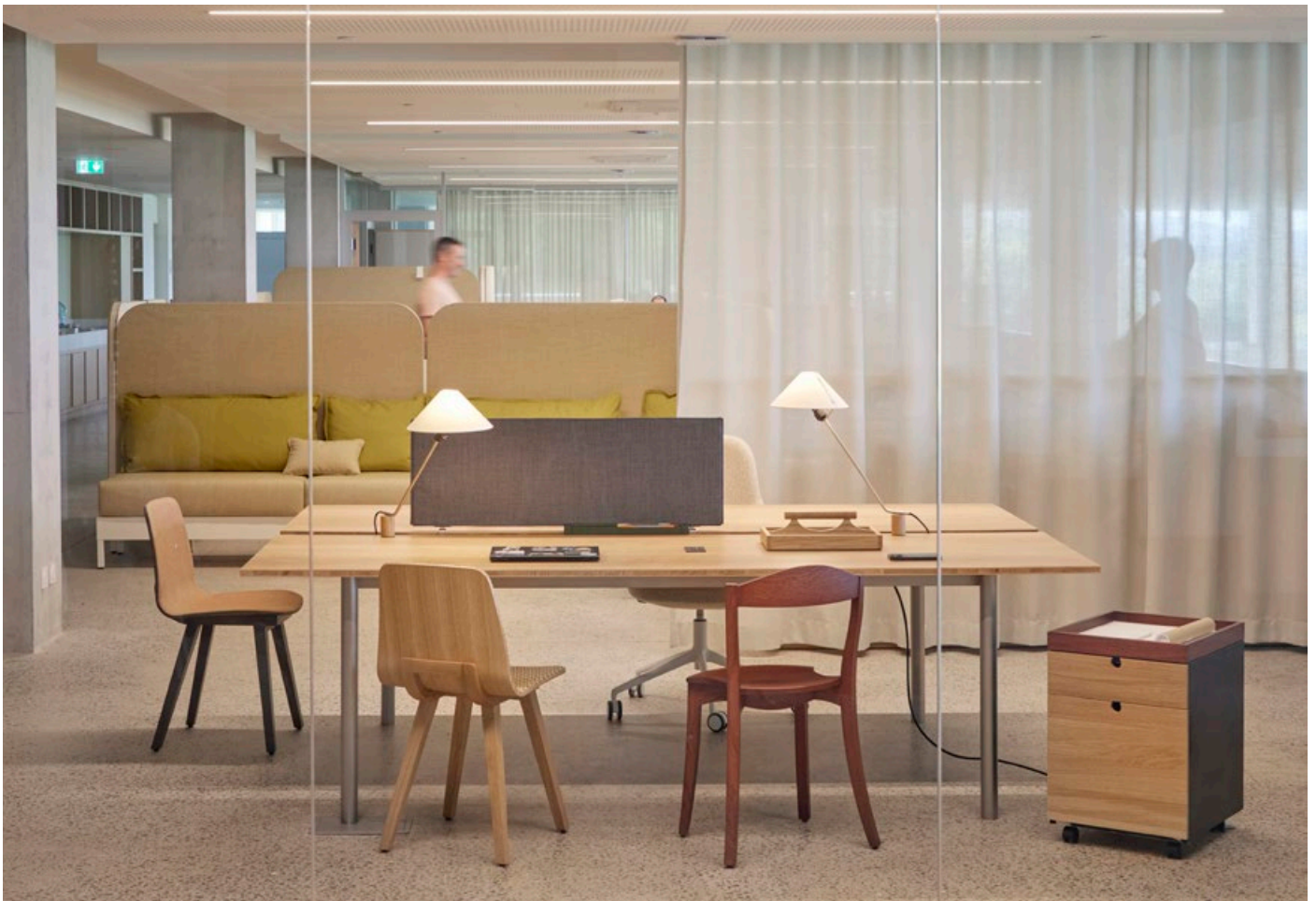


The Bibolina lamp stands out for its slim and discreet design. Pivoting, it provides precise individual lighting and brings rhythm to the whole.



The attachment system for the lamp and electronic devices is clever and easily accessible, thanks to supports integrated into the central opening.





The Bibolina storage unit completes the bench system. Mounted on castors, it moves easily under the desk or nearby. It features a metal structure, three-ply oak fronts and a fixed top.



Colour contrast between the solid wood and the desk's metal base. Optional matte nickel finish with a subtle grey / champagne tone.



Multifunctional central channel

A structuring element of the system, designed to accommodate cable routing and organise accessories in a discreet and functional way.

The central channel allows lamps, trays and other elements to be freely installed and moved, depending on use and needs.

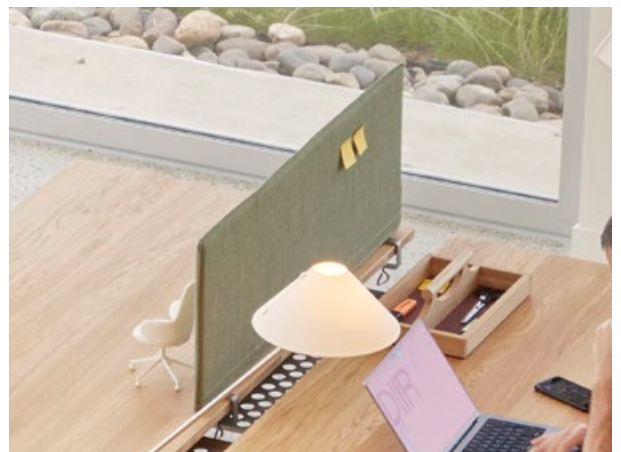
Bibolina lamp, designed to integrate along the entire length of the bench with 360° rotation capability. Matte nickel steel lamp stem with wooden base available in the Alki available finishes.



Storage unit on castors, a mobile storage solution that can easily be moved according to use. Compartment for hanging files with lock. L 395 x W 485 x H 590 mm



Side divider, designed to separate two workstations and create an individual workspace. Bases or clamps in matte nickel steel. H 360 x L 620 X H 21mm (with bases or optionally with clamps)



Front divider that can be freely positioned along the entire length of the central channel. Bases or clamps in matte nickel steel. H 360 x L 1000 X H 21mm (with clamps or optionally with bases)



Mobile tray, a functional element that moves along the central channel. Finish according to the available finishes L 400 x W 100 x H 30,5 mm



Toolbox, a solid oak storage accessory for everyday objects. Structure and base finishes according to the available finishes. L 350 x W 220 x H 100 mm

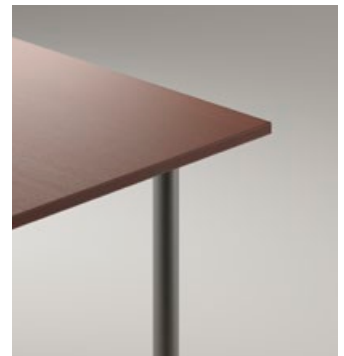

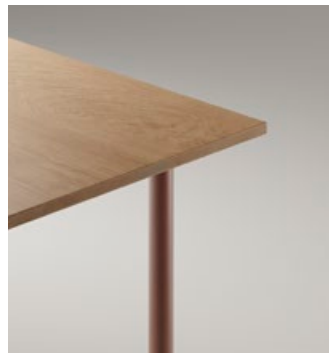

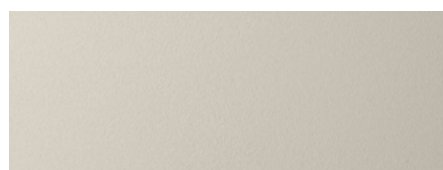

Finishes

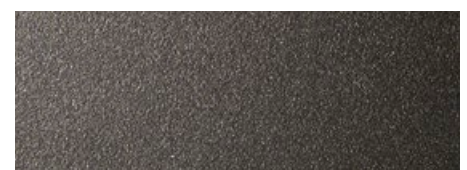

Bibolina Office is also available as an individual desk. This configuration comes in two sizes, offering a simple and coherent solution for personal workspaces.



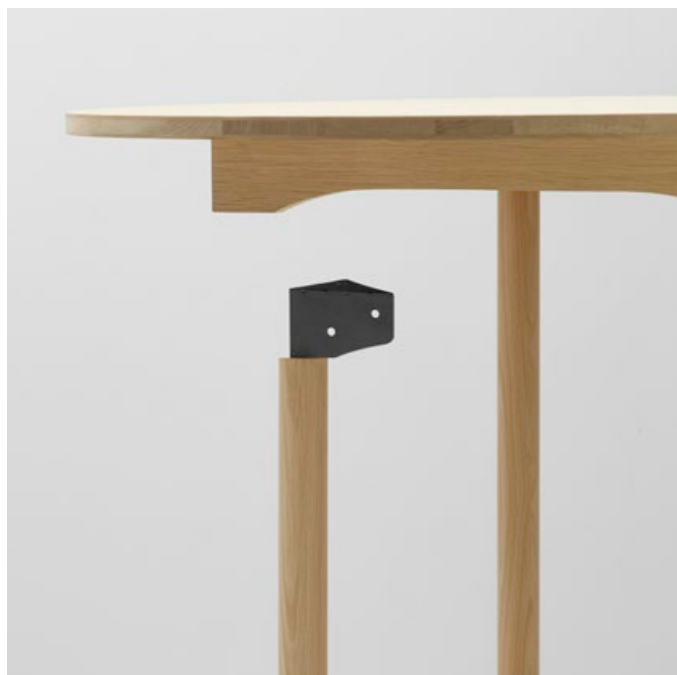
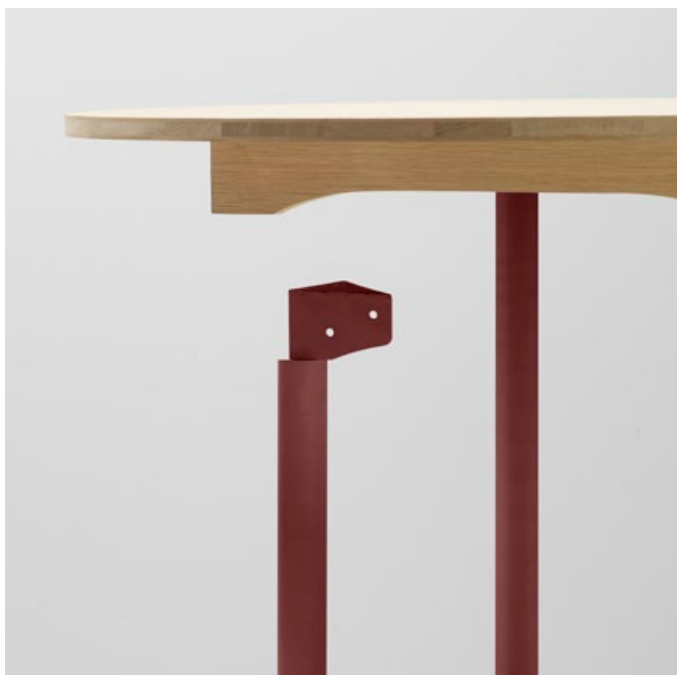
Desk Bibolina 1600
